ATTENDANCE

- If your student is ill, and will not be attending school, you must call the administrative office. Absences can not be reported by email or text.
- If your student arrives late, they should go to the administrative office to get a pass.
- If your student needs to leave early, or has an appointment during the day, you must send a written note for them to be excused. They will need to sign out in the administrative office before leaving, and sign back in upon return.

MASS TIMES AND INFORMATION

- School Mass is celebrated weekly on Thursday at 8:40 am for all students TK-12 at Holy Trinity Church. Watch the announcements for changes in the Mass schedule due to Holy Days of Obligation or other school events. Students help plan Mass and participate in various liturgical roles throughout the year.
- All guests are welcome to attend. Your child is welcome to come sit with you during Mass. The doors are locked once Mass begins for security purposes.
- Non-Catholic Students and Visitors: All students are required to attend school Masses, including non Catholic students. While non-Catholic Mass attendees are not able to receive the Eucharist, they are encouraged to come forward during communion, with their arms crossed over their chest, to receive a blessing from the Priest or Eucharistic Minister.
- Catholic students will be offered the opportunity to participate in Reconciliation several times during the year, or by appointment with the school chaplain. Contact Fr. Ross Caniglia frross@fdcatholic.com
- Holy Trinity Weekend Mass Times: Saturday 4:30 pm, Sunday 7:30 am, 10:00 am, 12:00 pm (Spanish Mass), and 7:30 pm. All families are welcome and encouraged to attend! Students will occasionally be assigned to help with liturgical roles during weekend Masses. Your child's teacher will notify you of the dates and times when they will be participating.
- Holy Trinity Daily Mass is held at 7:00 am Monday Friday and 8:00 am on Saturday. Parents and/or students are welcome to attend Mass before school.

REGISTRATION

- Preschool Registration takes place beginning in November.
- TK-12 Registration typically begins in February, and is done through Infinite Campus. It is important to register your child(ren) timely so plans can be made for staffing/classes for the following year. For help with registration, click HERE.

SCHOOL BOARD

- The St. Edmond School Board meets on the fourth Wednesday of each month except in July and December.
 Meetings are held at 5:15 pm in the school library. All are welcome to attend and time is given at the end of the meeting for visitors to ask questions and/or voice concerns.

SCHOOL PICKUP AND DROP OFF / BUS SERVICE

- School doors open at 7:30 am. Students may be dropped off at any of the main entrances. They should go to the lunch room (elementary for PS-5th grade or high school for 6th-12th) to wait for the first bell at 7:47 am. Students may purchase breakfast during this time. Elementary students will rotate (by grade) having the option to play in the gym during this time.
- School is dismissed at 2:55 pm. Elementary students are released from the doors on the elementary side of the building. Ask your child's teacher for details about which door they will be using. If you prefer, they can also be allowed to go to one of the other main entrances if you will be picking them up from the front or back parking lots.
- You may park on the street, any of the school parking lots, or the Holy Trinity Church parking lot. Please do not park and leave your car in the curved driveway in front of the administrative office. Pull as far ahead as possible to keep traffic moving. For afternoon pickup, please leave the outer lane open so traffic can flow through.
- **Bus Service** is available through the Fort Dodge Public School. Contact the Bus Barn at 515-576-6151 to register. There may be days where St. Edmond has school, but no bus service is available, because public schools are not in session.

- **Boot Bags** are a great option for elementary students for storing their winter gear. The PTC will offer an opportunity to order boot bags in the fall. This will be communicated by email and on social media.

SCRIP

- SCRIP is a program to purchase gift cards and earn a rebate to benefit St. Edmond. Half of the rebate will go to your account (to be credited to your tuition, lunch or SEAS bill) and the other half will go to the school to help fund special projects. - You will receive a green plastic folder you can use to submit your orders. This folder should be kept to use each year.
- Orders can be placed <u>HERE</u>, through the RaiseRight app, or by dropping off your order form at the school or business
 office. Orders placed by 9:00 am on Monday will be available for pickup (or sent home with your child) on Thursday.
- Some retailers have the option of reloading cards electronically or sending an e-card that can be used immediately. Some cards are also kept in stock and can be purchased during the SCRIP office hours.
- SCRIP Dress Down Days are held once per month. Watch the announcements or school calendar for the specific dates. If you place a SCRIP order for at least \$10, your child(ren) is allowed to be out of uniform for the day. Your child will need to take their order to the high school gym before school to receive their out of uniform pass for the day.
